IS THIS A NOTEBOOK?



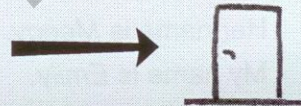
Yes, it is a notebook.

IS THIS A BAG?



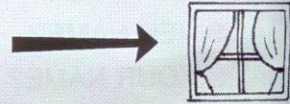
Yes, it is a bag.

IS **THAT** A WINDOW?



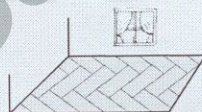
Yes, it is a window.

IS THIS A PEN?



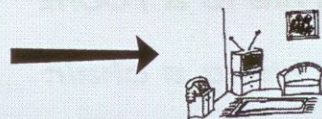
Yes, it is a pen.

IS THIS A FLOOR?



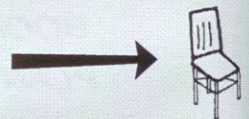
Yes, it is a floor.
