It's 3 a.m.  $(=before\ noon)$ . It's 5 p.m.  $(=after\ noon)$ .

What's the time? | It's 10 a.m. or: It's 4 p.m.

Is it 10 p.m.?

No, it isn't 10 p.m., but it's 10 a.m.

Is it 4 a.m.?

No, it isn't 4 a.m., but it's 4 p.m.

What time is noon?

Noon is at 12 p.m.

Do we have our lesson at noon?

Yes, we have our lesson at noon. or: No, we don't have our lesson at noon.



What's the time? ~ It's 10 a.m. or: It's 4 p.m.
