What do you get when you sunbathe in the sunshine?

When you **sunbathe** in the **sunshine**, you get a **suntan**.

Do you get a (sun)tan easily?

Yes, I get a (sun)tan easily.
or: No, I don't get a (sun)tan easily.

Where do people usually go when they want to sunbathe?

People usually go to the **seaside** when they want to **sunbathe**.

How frequently do you sunbathe at the seaside?

I **sunbathe** at the **seaside** *once a year*.

Can it be dangerous for your skin if you sunbathe too frequently?

Yes, it can be dangerous for your skin if you **sunbathe** too **frequently**.

spoil / spoilt / spoilt	[spɔɪl / spɔɪlt / spɔɪlt]
satisfaction	[sætɪs'fækʃn]

Have you ever spoilt anyone's birthday party?

Yes, I've **spoilt** someone's birthday party.
or: No, I've never **spoilt** anyone's ...
I forgot to bring the birthday present.

How can grandparents sometimes spoil their grandchildren?

Grandparents can sometimes **spoil** their grandchildren by *giving them too many sweets and toys*.

What can sometimes spoil a customer's satisfaction?

The fact that one could get a better price somewhere else can sometimes **spoil** a **customer's satisfaction**.



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
