### 1. Put the verbs in brackets in the future simple or continuous tenses (► 310).

1. Don't call me at 6. I ... **will be washing** ... (wash) my hair then. Call later.
2. Mother: Your face is dirty. ~ Child: All right, I ..... (wash) it.
3. In a few years' time we (live) ..... in houses heated  
by solar energy.
4. You've just missed the last train. ~ Don't worry! I (walk) .....
5. Before I leave the office, I (lock) ..... all the doors.
6. What (you, do) ..... at seven tomorrow morning? ~  
I (eat) ..... my breakfast.
7. What do you think the children (do) ..... when we get home?
8. Mother (on phone): My son has just burnt his hand very badly. ~  
Doctor: I (come) ..... at once.

### future perfect

We use **the future perfect** for an action that will be finished before a particular time in the future.

We use **will have + past participle** to make this tense.  
e.g. He **will have read** the whole book by Thursday.

### 2. Put the verbs in brackets in the future perfect tense (► 385).

1. In a week's time we (take) will have taken our exam.
2. I (finish) \_\_\_\_\_ this book by tomorrow morning.
3. By this time next year I (save) \_\_\_\_\_ 100 dollars.
