## Have to

 when something is necessary and you have no choice I have to to study for tomorrow's exams.

Erick **has to** clean the house before his parents arrive.

He **had to** buy some lemons first before he could make lemon juice.

Don't have to
- when something is
NOT necessary or
not required.

I don't have to do the laundry. My mom does it for me.

Erick **doesn't have to** clean the house. They **don't have to** come early tonight.
