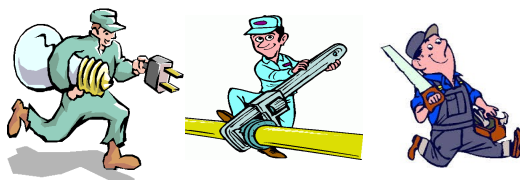




At the end of the lesson, the student will be able to:

A: What's wrong with it?

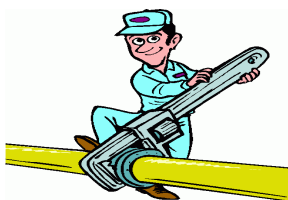
B: It's **leaking**.
