Let's Study

Artistic Type	this type likes working with designs and patterns. (ex. interior designers and architect)
Conventional Type	this type likes to follow instructions and routines (ex. an accountant and a police officer)
Investigative Type	like the doctors and pharmacists, they enjoy figuring out and solving problems
Social Type	jobs prefer to work with other people. A very good example for this is the health care provider (ex. nurses, doctors, physical therapists)
