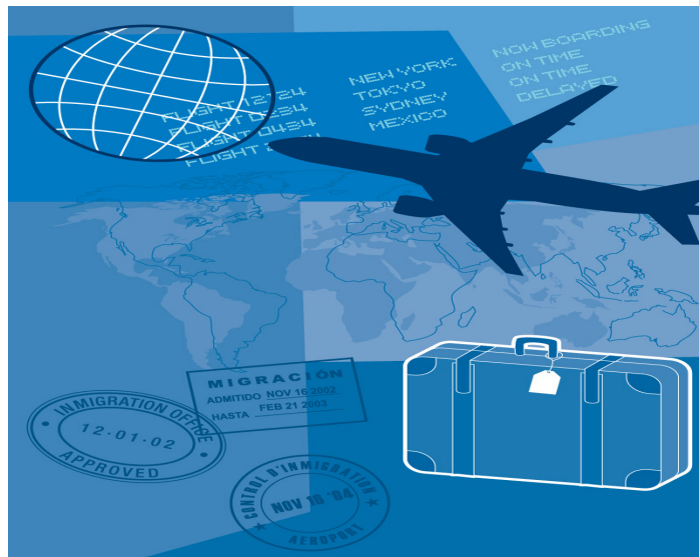




Departures

Taxi Driver: The airport is just ahead. Is your trip domestic or international? There are two terminals one for the domestic and one for international.

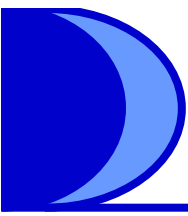
Jun: International. I'm flying to Hong Kong.

Main Vocabulary:

- **flight-** go into an airplane and each time you travel in an airplane.
- **domestic-** flight within the country
- **international-** flight outside the country
- **Terminals-** part of an airport- building inside the airport.
- **Airline-** ex. Cathay Pacific
- **drop (somebody) off-** stop and let the passenger get out
