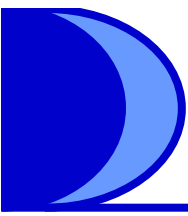




### 3) Giving Indoor and Outdoor Directions



<b>EXPRESSION</b>	<b>WHEN TO USE IT</b>
- How do I get to ...?	A question for asking a direction to a certain place.
- Giving directions Go straight on (until you come to..)	Starting statement in giving directions to someone.
<b>WORDS USE IN TELLING LOCATION</b> - Go along	It means follow this path or this street
- Cross	To move, pass, or extend from one side to the other side of (a street, river, etc.).
- Take the first/second road on the left/right	Walk on the road which is found in the first street at the right or left side.-
- straight on	Walk straight
