

**Rich and Poor Worlds** 





The common phrases used to describe a rich world are the "developed countries" and the "advanced industrial countries". To describe very poor countries, we usually refer to "The Third World".

It can be more diplomatic to speak of "the developing countries", though this description is often applied to countries which are not so very poor. Economists also refer to "the North South divide" to emphasize that countries in the northern hemisphere are generally richer than those in the southern hemisphere namely Africa and Latin America. People in the rich world have mixed attitudes towards giving aid to Third World countries. As for the question, "who must help who?"
