1. Where are you heading?	- asking for the destination	- Where to?
2. Don't mind	- if its okay with the person to ask something	<ul><li>If it's okay to ask</li><li>If it's not a trouble</li></ul>
3. I'm on my way	- the person is walking towards somewhere	- I'm going to - I'm heading to
4. Drop you off	- the taxi will stop and let the passenger get off the taxi.	- stopped you at
